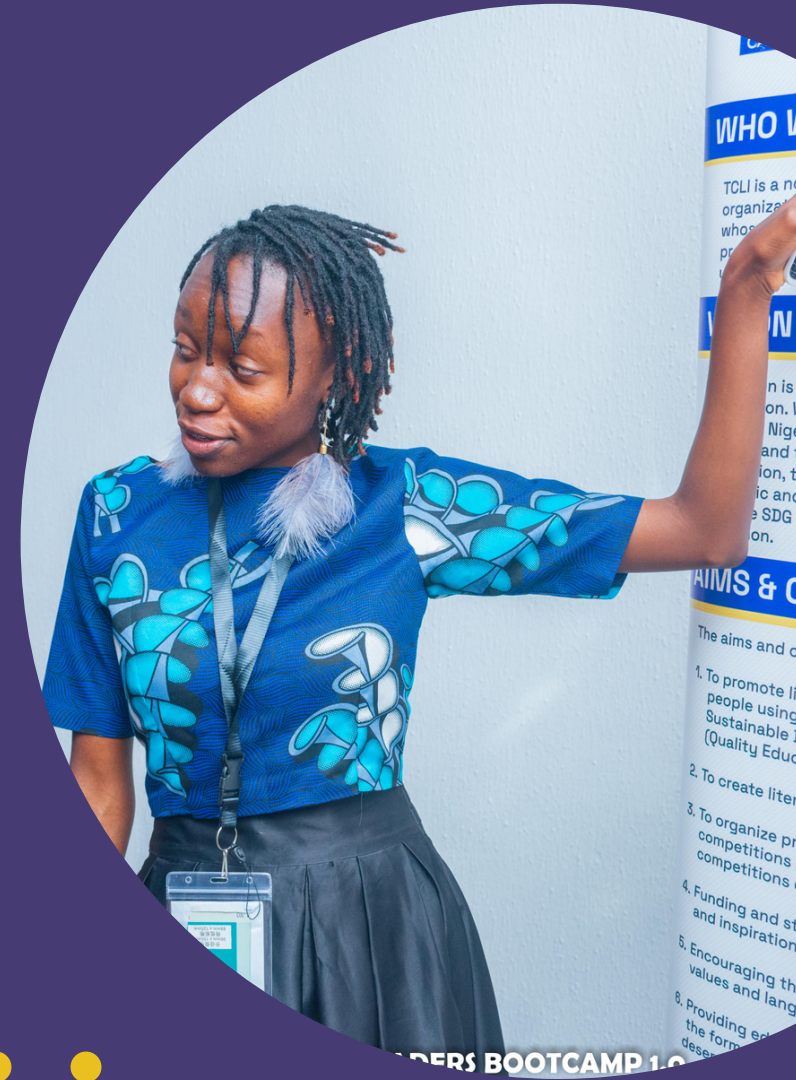

TCLI also engages in community interventions and offers humanitarian services to widows, single moms and orphans.

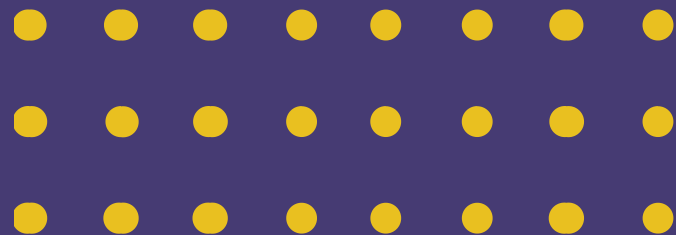

SCHOLARSHIP DRIVE

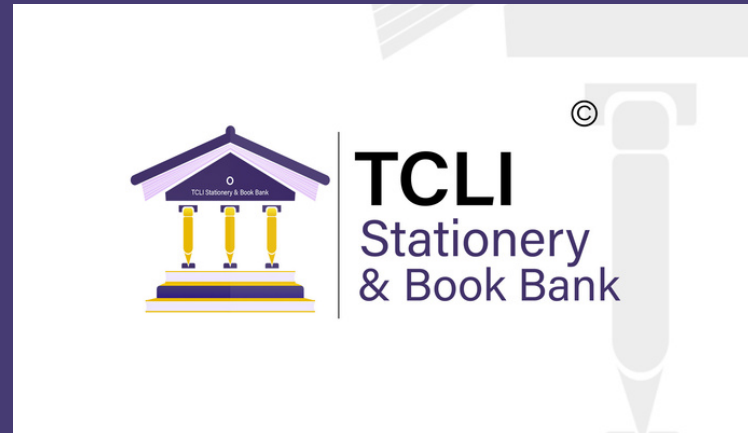
We renewed the scholarships of all existing beneficiaries under the scheme (5 beneficiaries).

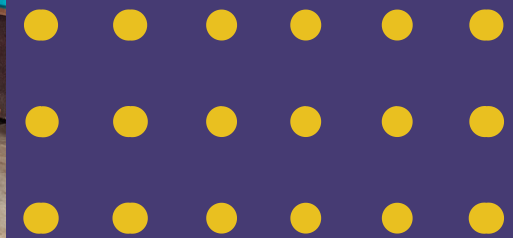


On the 20th of June, 2022 we launched the TCLI Stationery & Book Bank which is aimed at providing FREE stationery to children in Jos and beyond who truly cannot afford to buy stationery to aid their learning.



758 PIECES OF STATIONERY DISTRIBUTED

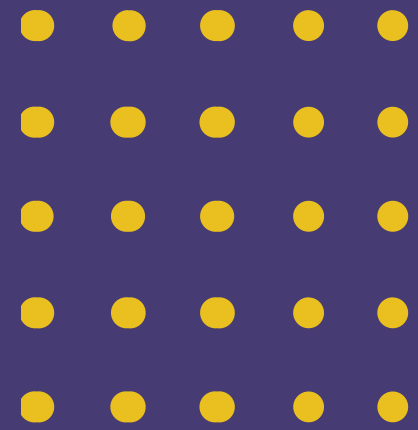

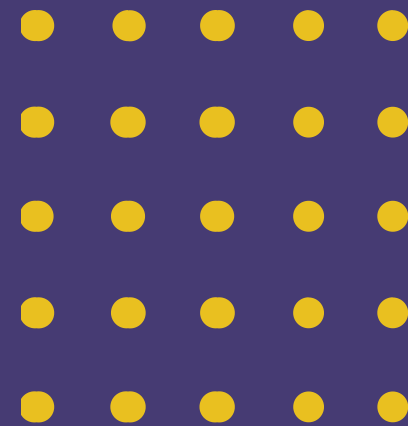

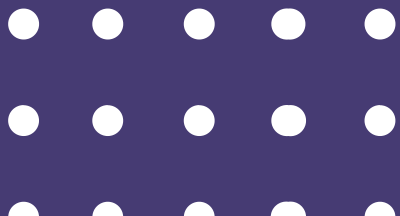
TOWARDS SDG 17...

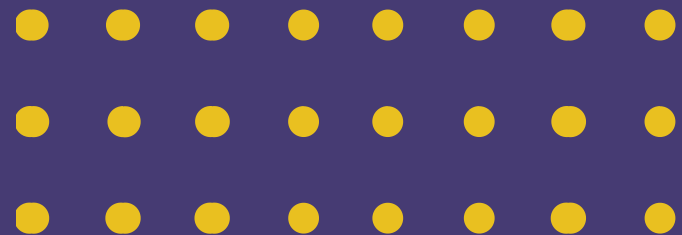
